

The reorganization meeting of Hanover Borough Council was called to order at 6:00 PM Monday Evening, January 4, 2010 in the Hanover Borough Council Chamber, 44 Frederick Street, Hanover, Pennsylvania with Mayor Adams presiding.

District Justice Dubs administered the Oath of Office to Mayor Adams.

On roll call, the following members of Council were present: Mr. McLin, Mr. Delzingaro, Mr. Leppo, Mrs. Griffin, Mrs. Stonesifer, Mr. Hufnagle, Mr. Funke, Ms. Hormel, Mr. Eline, Mr. Gerken; Mayor Adams; Solicitor McKonly; Manager Rebert and Secretary Miller.

Secretary Miller reported that Certificates of Election have been filed for the following recently elected Council Members: Gerald Funke, First Ward; Heidi Hormel, Second Ward; Anthony R. Delzingaro, Third Ward; Bernard Sonny Eline, Fourth Ward; and Thomas J. Hufnagle, Jr., Fifth Ward.

Mayor Adams administered the Oath of Office to elected councilpersons Gerald Funke, Heidi Hormel, Anthony R. Delzingaro, Bernard Sonny Eline, Thomas J. Hufnagle, Jr. and Tax Collector Leroy Wentz.

Mayor Adams announced that Council was ready to reorganize for years 2010-2011 and that the Chair was ready to accept nominations for President of Council.

Mr. Delzingaro nominated Mr. John Gerken for President of Council; and Ms. Heidi Hormel for Vice President of Council. There were no other nominations for president or vice president. It was moved by Mrs. Griffin, seconded by Mr. Eline to close the nominations. Motion carried. The nomination was passed 10-0 in favor of Mr. Gerken for Council President and Ms. Hormel for Vice-President.

Mayor Adams turned the Chair over to the newly elected President, Mr. John Gerken.

President Gerken thanked Council for electing him as President and Ms. Hormel as Vice-President, and announced the floor was now open for nominations to the following appointed offices for 2010 - 2011: Borough Manager, Borough Secretary, Borough Treasurer, Assistant Borough Secretary, Assistant Borough Treasurer and Solicitor.

It was moved by Mr. Delzingaro, seconded by Mr. Eline to nominate the remaining positions as slated: Borough Manager – Mr. Bruce Rebert; Borough Secretary – Ms. Dorothy C. Miller; Borough Treasurer – Mrs. Cynthia J. Wyatt; Assistant Borough Secretary – Mr. Bruce Rebert; Assistant Borough Treasurer – Mrs. Susan Racey; and Borough Solicitor – Attorney G. Steven McKonly. Motion carried.

It was moved by Mr. Funk, seconded by Mrs. Stonesifer to approve the following dates and times as regular meetings of Hanover Borough Council for fiscal years 2010 and 2011: The fourth Wednesday of January, February, and March; and the second and fourth Wednesdays of April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November, and December at 7:30 P.M. in the Hanover Borough Council Chamber, 44 Frederick Street, Hanover, Pennsylvania. (NOTE: November, 2010 and November, 2011 the meeting will be the fourth Tuesday.)

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Adams introduced Ms. Kate Brady, 624 Hobart Road, Hanover, Pennsylvania to Council for her new position as Poet Laureate for a period of one year from January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010 with an optional one (1) year renewal. Mr. Adams thanked family, friends and citizens for their support and promised to fill his new position with honor and integrity.


OTHER MATTERS
