

President Gerken convened the public meeting of Hanover Borough Council Wednesday Evening March 2, 2011 at 5:00 PM in the Hanover Municipal Building, 44 Frederick Street, Hanover, Pennsylvania, as advertised.

The meeting started with the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a moment of silent prayer.

On roll call the following Hanover Borough Council Members answered as present: Mr. Dennin, Mr. Funke, Mr. Gerken, Mr. McLin and Mrs. Yingling; Mayor Adams; Solicitor McKonly; Manager Krebs and Secretary Miller. Absent were Council Members Delzingaro, Eline, Hormel, Griffin and Hufnagle. Present for the regional joint bid opening were the following representatives of local governments: Conewago Township Manager Hagarman, Union Township Secretary Bollinger, West Manheim Township Manager Null and West Manheim Township Supervisors Hartlaub and Williams; McSherrystown Administrator Cook; and Germany Township Supervisor Valko & Roadmaster Ridinger. Absent was a representative from Penn Township.

JOINT BID OPENING

President Gerken announced that all bid tabulations will be presented at a meeting of the public bodies Wednesday, March 23, 2011 at 7:30 PM for their consideration and award. Bid tabulations will be forwarded to all bidders after the March 23, 2011 meeting. Opening and recording tonight is without reference to the validity-acceptability of the bid document, which will be determined by the public bodies in public session.

Communications:


